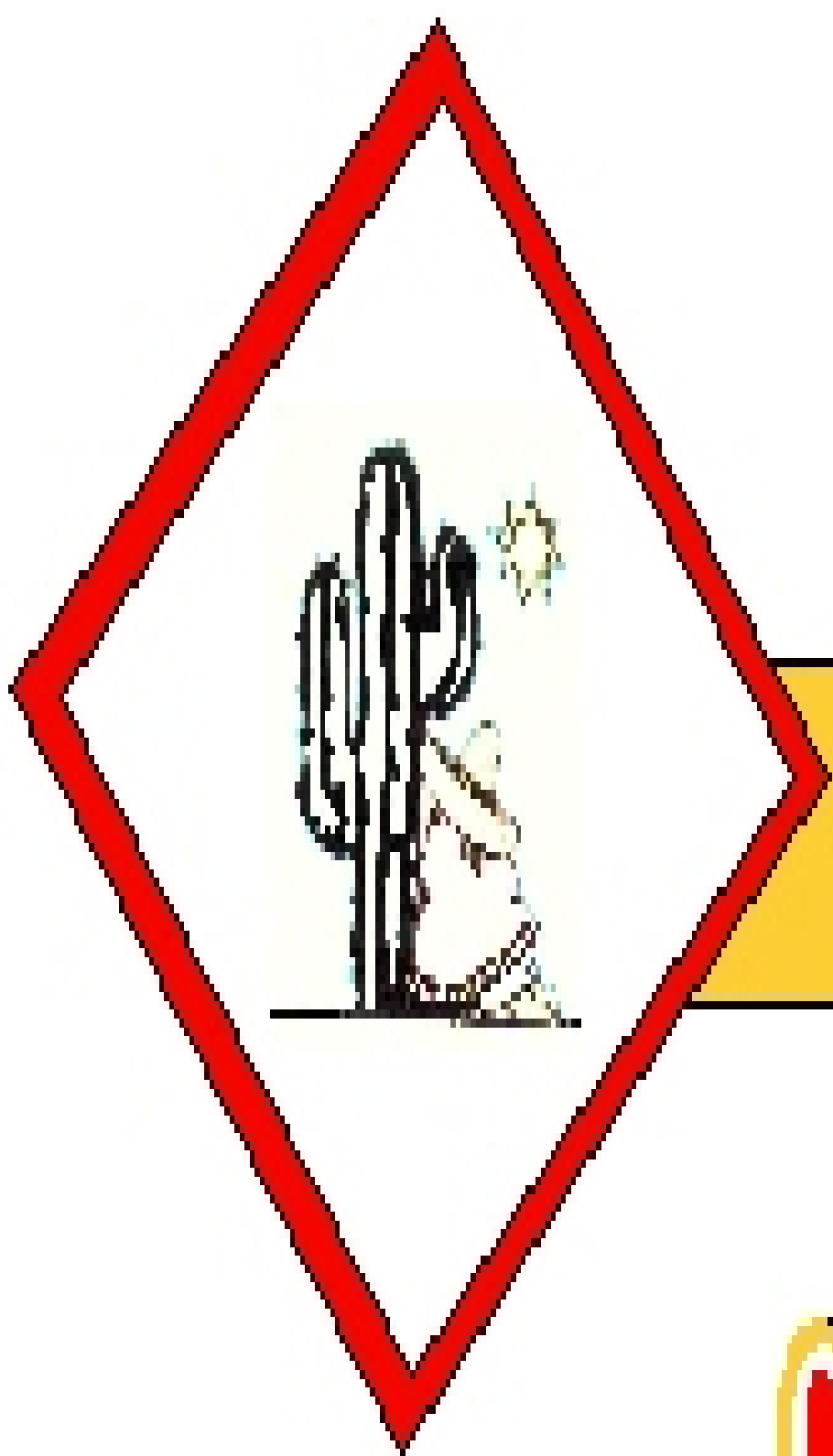

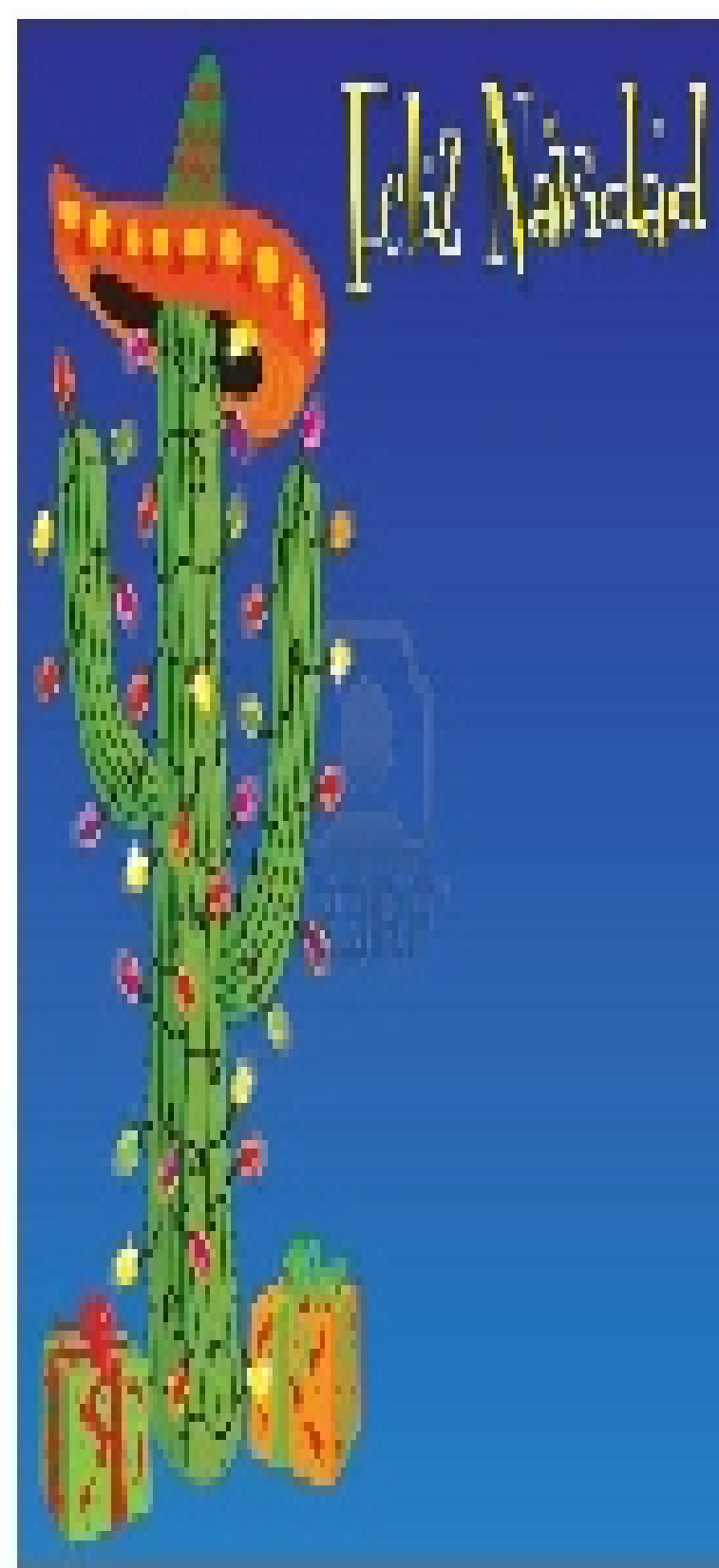

Camping news you can use!

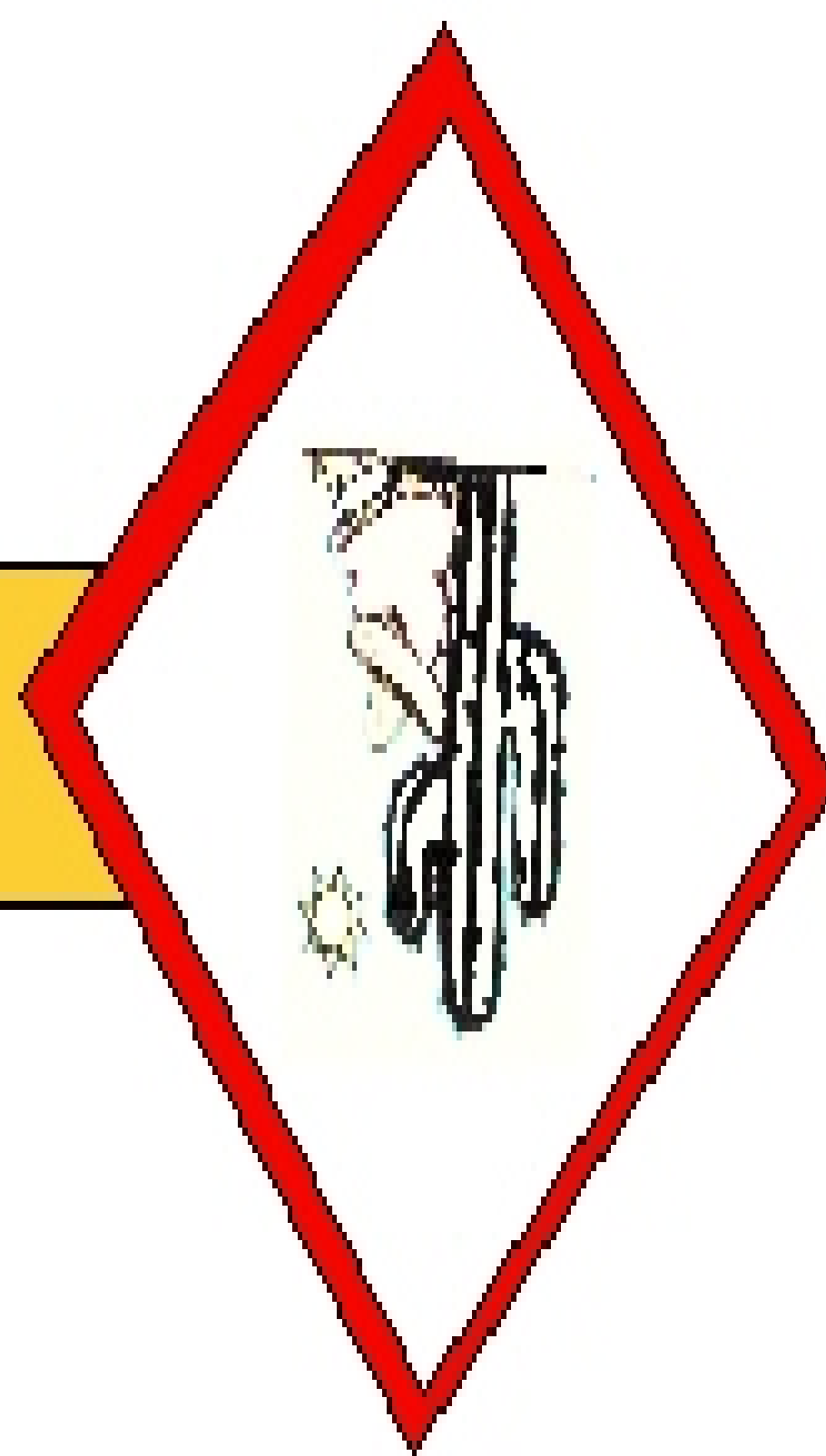
Here is to a better 2012

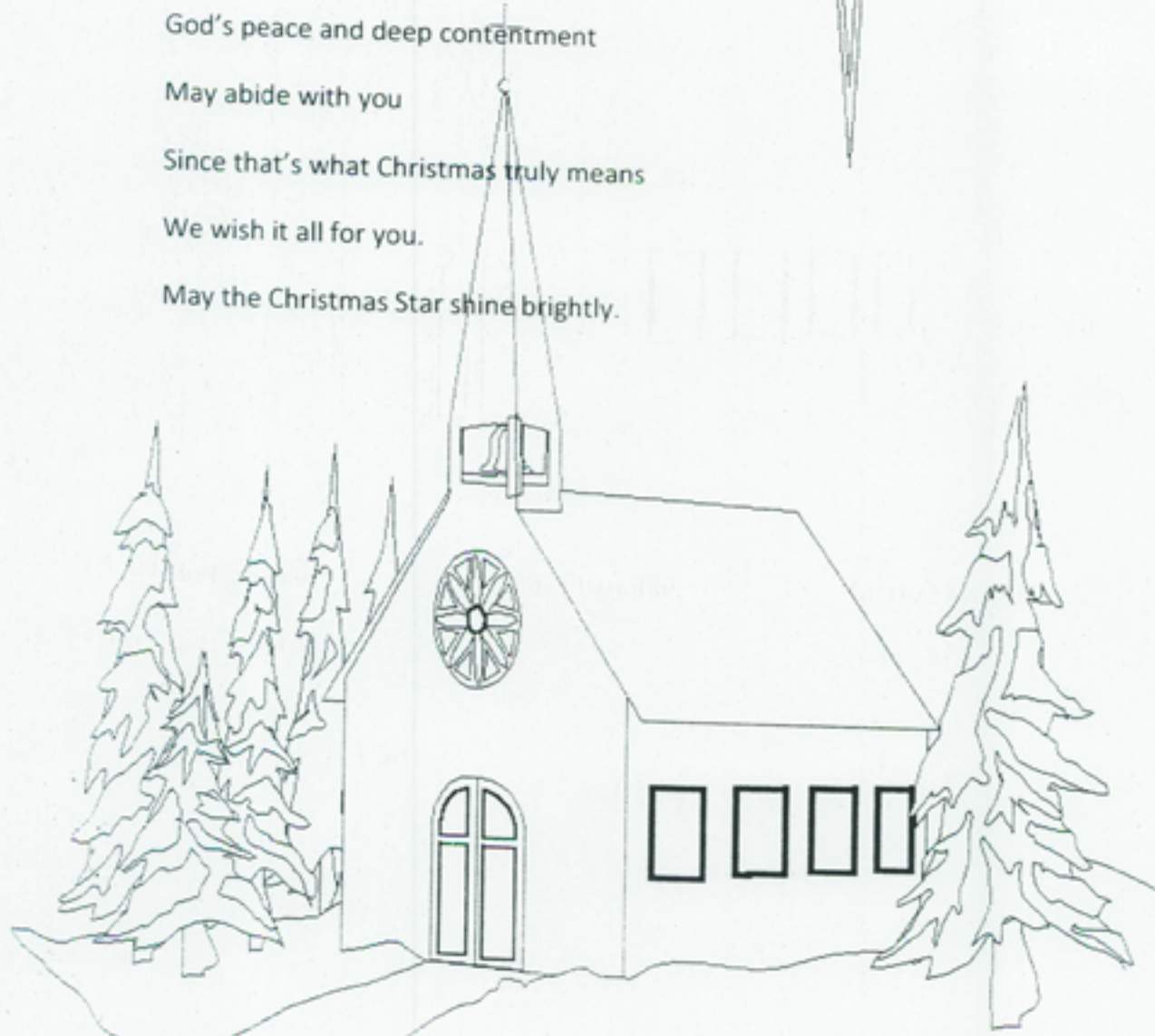
